UNMAS Action: National Capacity Strengthening & Development

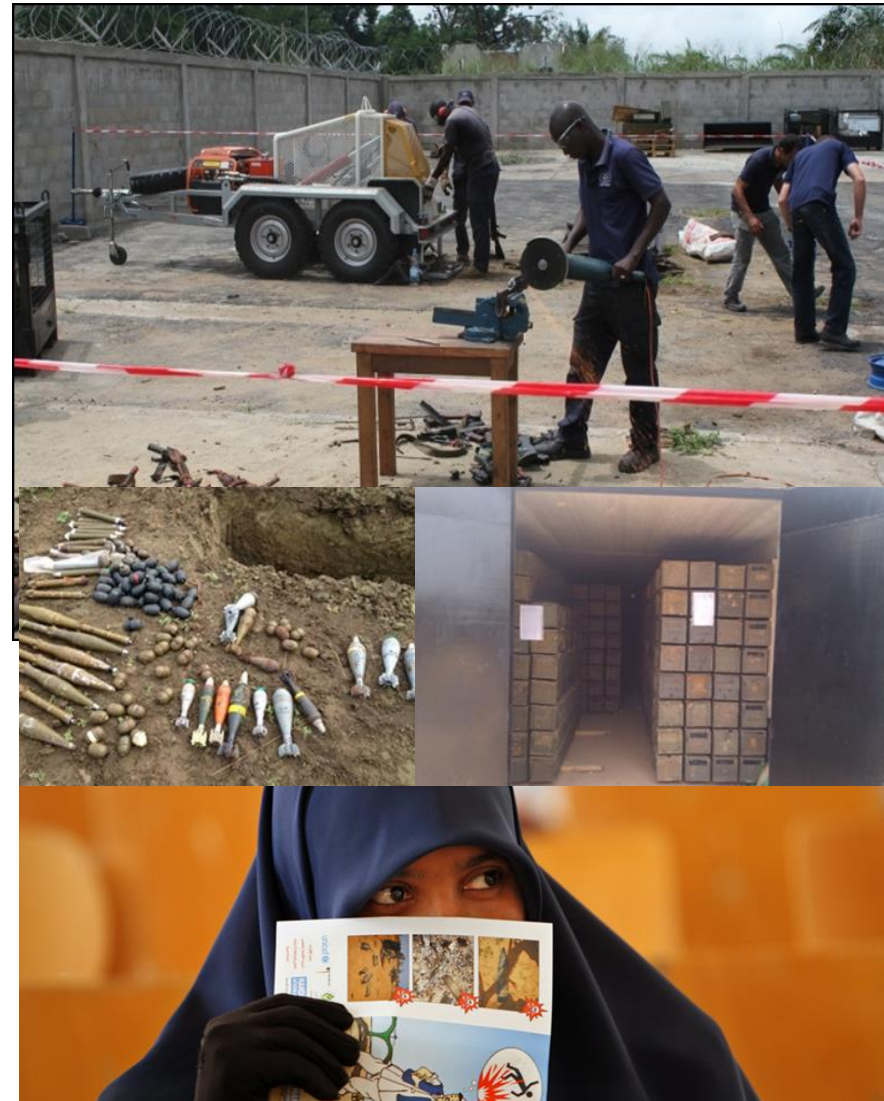
- A context specific & tailored approach.

UNMAS Best Practices

- **Thorough planning and programming are a must:**
 - **Must be affected country's needs driven, rather than capacity led;**
 - **Must dialogue with national and local partners outside the country's capital;**
 - **A phased intervention based on a realistic assessment of existing capacity, including a well tested rapid response capacity;**
- **Gender mainstreaming is an enabler;**
- **Promote & Apply international standards.**
