

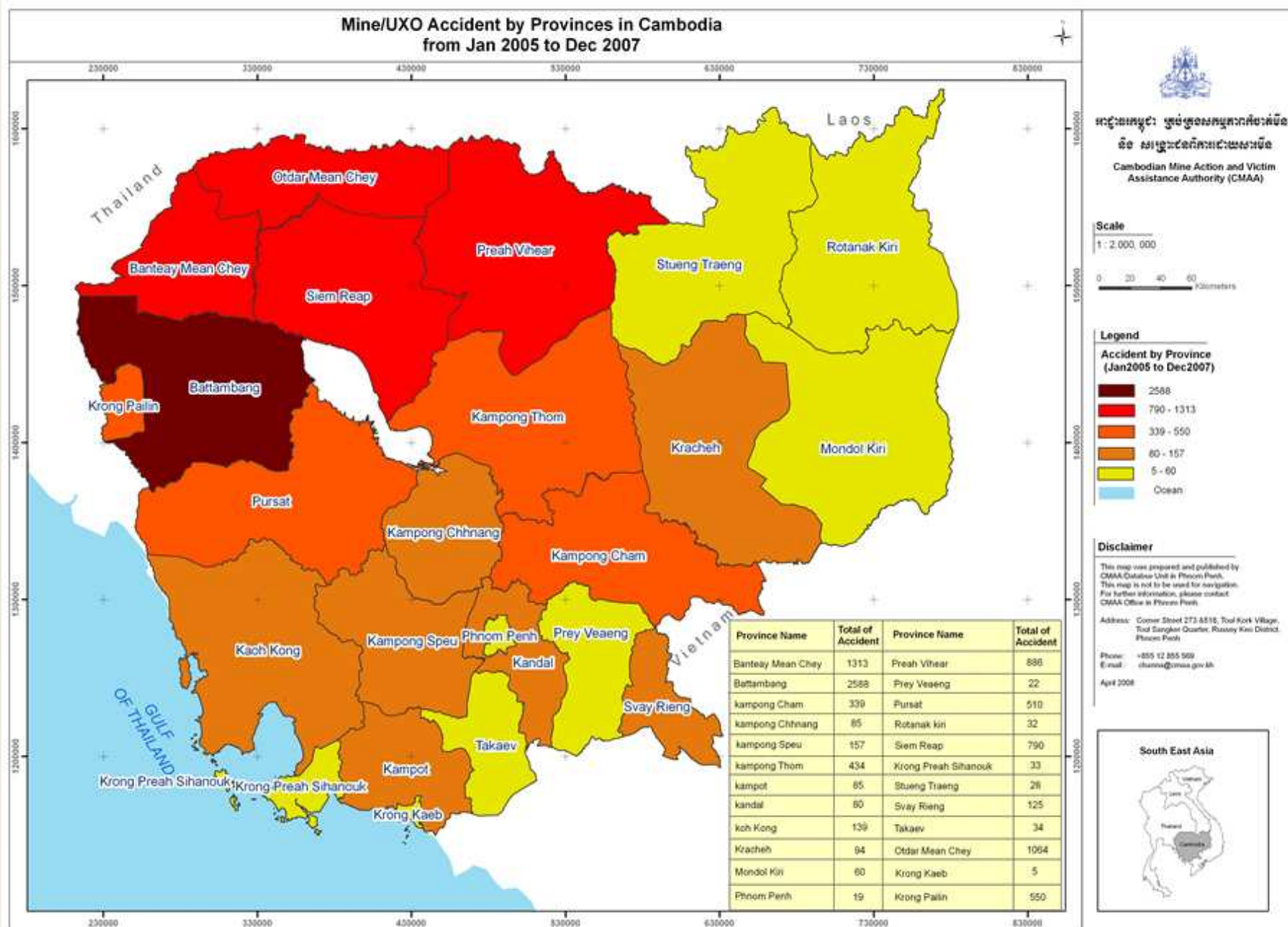

- ☀ - Civil and regional war from 60's to 90's
- ☀ - The North Western regions bordering Thailand are contaminated by Landmines
- ☀ - Eastern regions are contaminated mostly by ERW
- ☀ - More than 2.75 millions tons of bomb were dropped from air plan during the regional conflicts





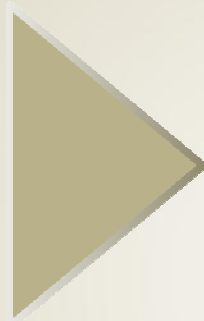

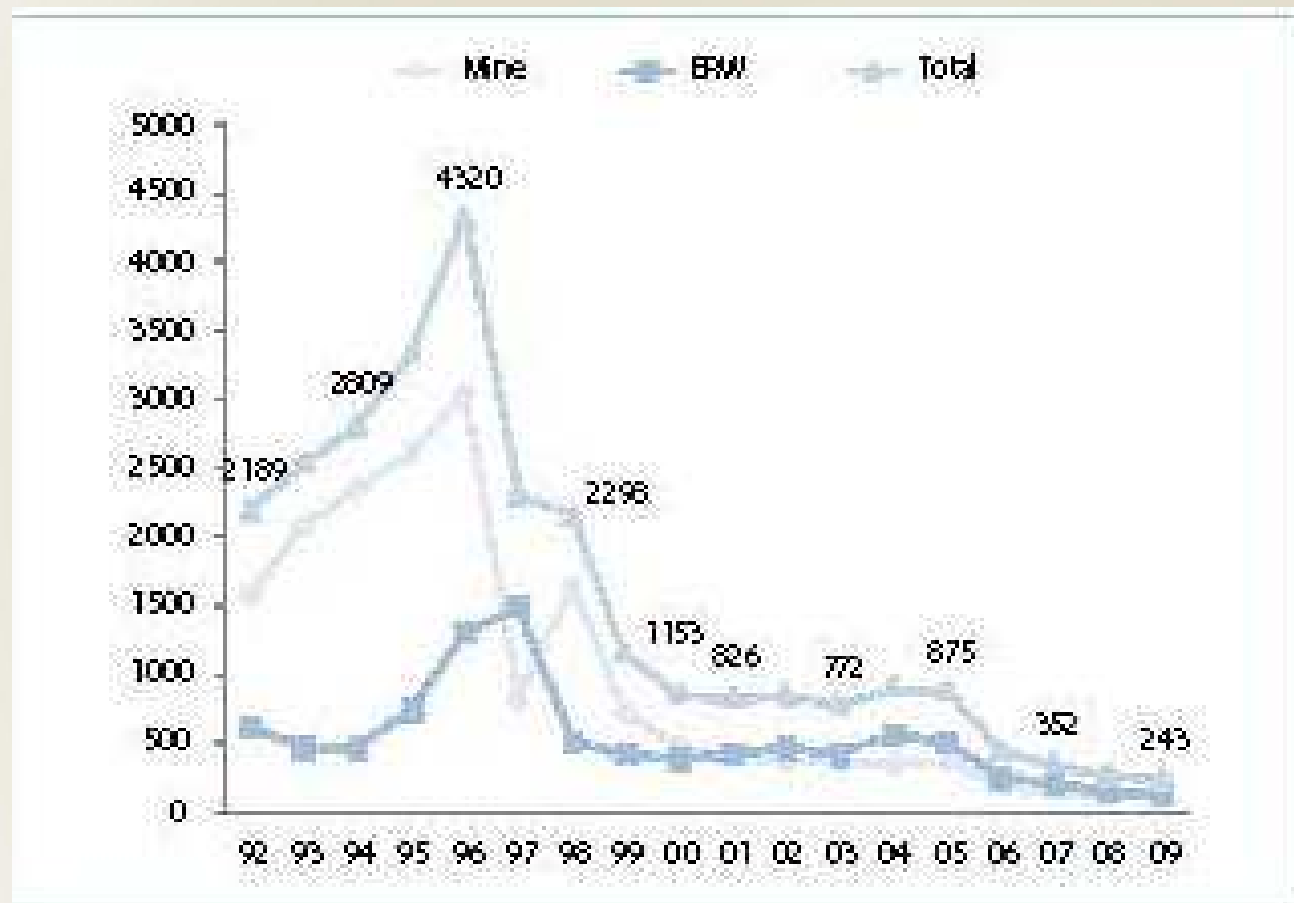


All mine actions and plan

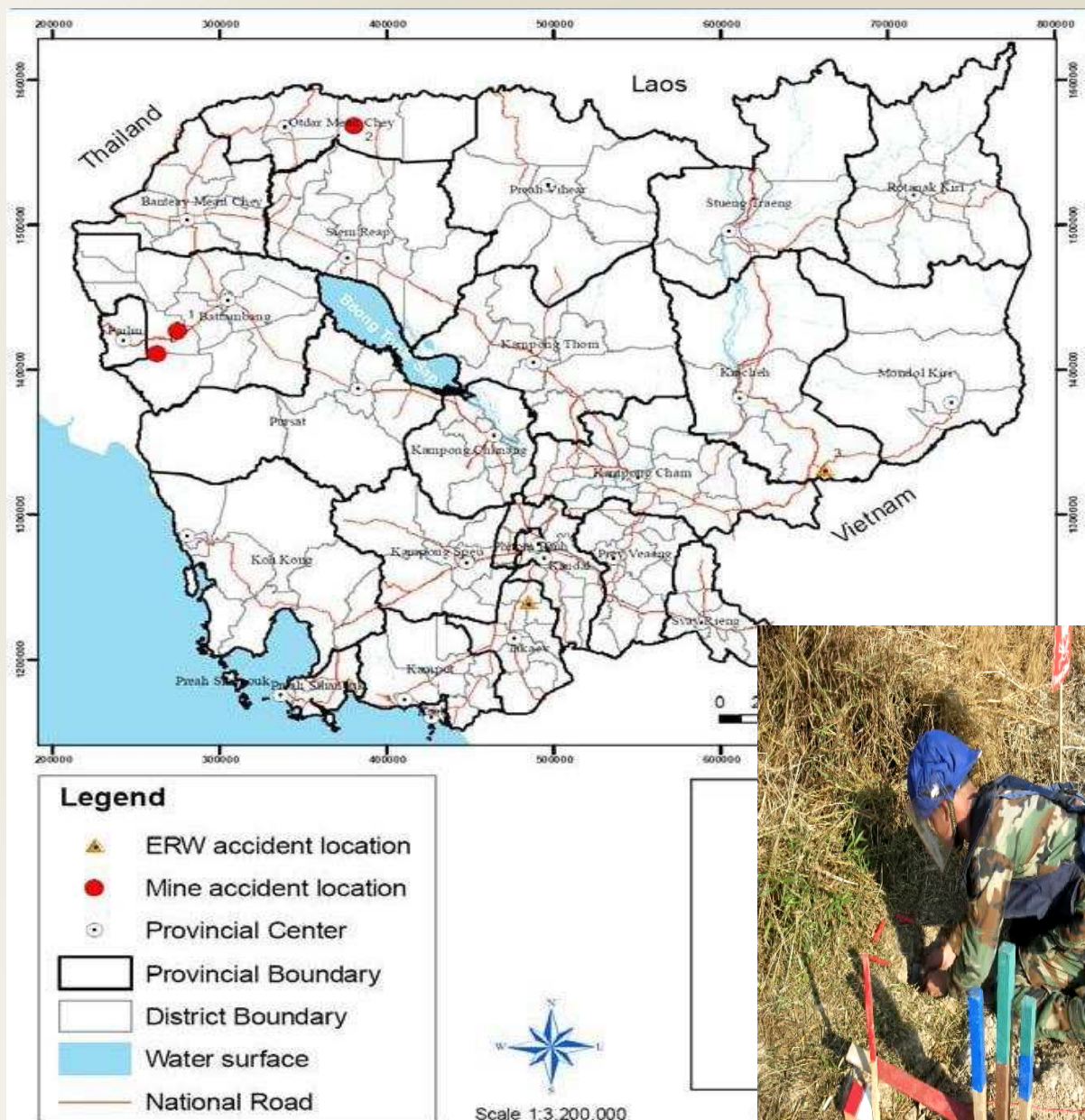
